Countdown to Liftoff

Ski season is only a few months away and it is time for my annual snowfall prediction! (If people living in Colorado can make hurricane predictions, it only seems fair that someone living in Houston make snowfall predictions.) I have been studying in great detail past data on El Nino and La Nina and will go out on a limb and say that this year will be about average (maybe more, maybe less) and that at least two of our trips will have the great fortune of experiencing an epic powder day during their trip! The other trips will still have great skiing because of the incredible job done by the ski resorts to maintain good skiing conditions.

Have you already signed up for a trip and now you're wondering what you should do next? Forget shopping for new gear or new clothes, now is the time to get serious about your skiing fitness. Most of our members already do a decent job of staying in shape year round, but with only a few months left before we hit the slopes, now is a good time to put in some extra effort on your conditioning. Whatever your activity of choice (fitness classes, bicycling, jogging, swimming, skating, etc), extra time spent during the next few months doing aerobic conditioning and strength training will pay big dividends during your snow ski vacation. Skiing 5 days and showing up each day at Happy Hour looking refreshed can be grueling!

One thing you may have noticed when reviewing our trips on the website is that several of the prices have changed. We never increase prices once they have been published but we will reduce prices every chance we get! After the trip articles were first published in the August Sitzmarke, full package trip prices for Beaver Creek, Mammoth, Whitefish, and Breckenridge TSC have been reduced due to better air contracts.

Here is a trip status update after 6 weeks of trip signup:

- Vail December (both long and short trips)
 31 signed up. We are reducing condo space October 1. Check with the TC for remaining spots available.
- **Beaver Creek** (both short and long trips) 67 signed up but lots of space available on the short trip. We can expand the long trip in groups of four to fill a 2 bedroom condo.
- Madesimo, Italy 31 signed up, only 9 remaining!
- **Mammoth, California** 9 signed up, only 7 remaining!
- Taos, New Mexico (both long and short trips) – 13 either signed up or pending.
 Check with the TC for remaining space available.

- Whitefish, Montana 38 signed up, now waitlist only.
- Breckenridge TSC Trip Feb 28 to Mar 7 (2 short trips and a long trip) 30 signed up for the three trips. Check with the TC for remaining spots available.
- Breckenridge Spring Break Mar 14-21 lots of space available for both adults and youths!
- Tuscany, Italy 26 signed up, 24 available.

If you are considering travelling with the club, visit www.spacecity.org to see the trips offered and the current status. Then plan on attending the October General Meeting and visit in person with our trip leaders. After visiting with the trip leaders, you will be able to choose a trip and sign up during the meeting so do not forget to bring your checkbook. Signing up requires payment of a deposit (\$150 for a domestic trip; \$300 for Madesimo; \$490 for Tuscany full package).

I look forward to another great year of skiing and traveling with the Space City Ski & Adventure Club!

It goes like this: I meet someone who is so interesting and is doing good things for the club. I think, that's a person that others in the club should get to know. Then I interview them for a Member Profile for the Sitzmarke and find out how really cool they are. Here we go again, another of those people you need to get to know.

Member Profile – Jo Barrie

Jo Barrie's first ski experience was at Boston Mills in Ohio as a teenager. After that first day, she could not understand why anyone

would want to stomp through slush and snow, get freezing cold and nearly get frostbitten in exchange for a three-minute thrill ride down a short hill. She tried it again ten years later at Zermatt, Switzerland. This time she got it. She learned about ski technique from a European instructor whose English was limited to "ski like this" and "no, no, no!" Regretfully, she allowed 25 years to pass before starting over on the Chickadee slope at Snowbird in Utah.

She joined the Space City Ski & Adventure Club in 2010

and now skis once a year, attempting to perfect her cruising technique. She states that maybe one day she'll get past the easy blue runs, but if not, it's okay because she never ceases to be awed by nature's splendor as seen from the chair lifts. She enjoys getting away from the city and breathing in that fresh cold mountain air.

She has had many wonderful travel experiences in addition to her skiing. While in high school, she lived in Costa Rica for a month with a Costa Rican family. Later, she lived in Saudi Arabia for a couple of years and has traveled to interesting places such as Istanbul, Hong Kong, Bali, Greece, and Amsterdam.

Jo has one son, a Texas Tech graduate who is gainfully employed here in Houston. She has custody of three cats and a fish tank and works as an administrative assistant for a small private investment firm. 
