Countdown to Liftoff

I hope you and your family had a safe and Happy New Year! Our first ski trip of the year was to Vail, Colorado during December and by all accounts everyone had an excellent time. Thanks to Bob Olsen for doing his usual good job as Trip Coordinator.

In just a few days, our second trip of the year will be departing for Beaver Creek. This is the Texas Ski Council Traditional trip and almost 400 people from the various Texas ski clubs will be making the trip. Later in January we have two more trips departing – an international trip to Madesimo, Italy and the Texas Ski Council Winter Shoot Out trip to Mammoth, California. Over 125 of our

club members will be on one of those three trips.

In February and March we have ski trips planned to Taos New Mexico, Whitefish Montana, Breckenridge Colorado and Winter Park Colorado. If you suddenly realize you made a terrible decision by not signing up for one of these trips, it may not be too late! Often times we can expand a trip if there is enough interest to add an additional condo (i.e., add 4 more participants to trip). There is also a chance that someone on one of these trips will need to cancel for some reason and a space will become available. If you have an interest in any of these trips, please let the Trip Coordinator know and they can advise you of the trip status.

Tired of all this information on skiing and you can hardly wait for summer? The Board of Directors recently approved a May 2015 trip to Mexico's Riviera Maya. The club will be staying at the all-inclusive Barceló Maya Colonial Hotel, located south of Playa del Carmen in the Barceló Maya Beach Resort. Round trip airfare on United Airlines and ground transportation to/from the resort is included in the full package. Complete details will be posted on the website soon!

There is still space available for the Fall 2015 trip to Tuscany, Italy. The tour operator will soon begin filling unsold seats so we expect the remaining seats to go quickly. Signing up requires payment of a \$490 deposit for the full package/\$370 for the land package. Deposits are refundable until April 15, 2015, less a \$30 club cancellation fee. Trip insurance is available for an additional \$270 full package/\$240 land package. That protects you from a financial loss should you need to cancel after April 15 and before the trip departure date. If you are considering signing up for this trip, you do not want to

delay much longer. Full details for the <u>Discover Tuscany Trip</u> are available on our <u>website</u>.

If you want to visit with our trip leaders about any of the trips we have planned, attend the January 19th General Meeting and visit in person with our Trip Coordinators and Assistant Trip Coordinators. They will answer your questions about the trips including the current status. Remember the January meeting has been moved to January 19 which is the 3rd Monday in January.

I look forward to another great year of skiing and traveling with the Space City Ski & Adventure Club!

Member Profile The Big Dogs

Ever since joining the Space City Ski Club I have always heard mention of "The Big Dogs". So I set out to find out who they are and what they do. It was hard to track this group down. People would say things like, "I tag along with them sometimes but I'm not really one of them." Finally, I got a name that most agreed would be one of these creatures, Keith Kirkman. Hmmm......I thought to myself. I am getting close! Then I asked our President, Melinda, and it turns out that Keith

is considered the leader. She smiled and said she would help me. Now, I had made the connection.

Keith explained that they are a group that likes to ski black runs. They enjoy the steep runs, powder, moguls, and trees. He said anyone who likes to ski those types of runs is welcome to ski with the group. The only requirement is no whining, and you must keep up with the pack. had accomplished my goal and was willing to move on to the next membership challenge.

A ski council is an organization whose regular membership consists substantially of not-for-profit voluntary membership clubs (& their members) of which snow skiing (in various forms) is a major activity. The term ski council is meant to include some organizations that perform the above function, but include in their names the word association instead of council.

The Ski Councils throughout the United States have certain functions in common with each other but also have differences.

U.S. is divided into 3 broad geographic sections for easier location of Ski Councils. The East Coast includes the Southeast, Central includes all the middle tier of states and the West Coast covers from the Rocky Mountains west.

Texas Ski Council (TSC) is a non-profit, all volunteer organization consisting of 14 clubs throughout the State of Texas. The members of each club have at least one common interest -- snow sports. The purpose of the TSC is to promote individual and group interest in skiing and snowboarding.

TSC is able to secure economical group travel discounts for its members with ski & travel destinations throughout the United States, Canada, Europe, Asia and the Southern Hemisphere.
